

DoT (Department of Telecommunications) is launching the **Sanchar Saathi Mobile App** to deliver these citizen-centric services at the fingertips of the citizens. Sanchar Saathi App is available for both android and iOS devices, thereby increasing its reach to approximately 90 crore subscribers. Upon installation, the app facilitates the registration of numbers linked to the SIMs on the citizen's phone. Citizens can access other features, such as identifying all mobile connections under their name, blocking, and tracing lost mobiles.

Its user-friendly interface ensures that even first-time smartphone users can navigate and benefit from its services. Citizens are encouraged to download and use the app, explore its features, report any fraud, and provide their valuable feedback.
